MUSIC CAN CHANGE THE WORLD

Future Yard is a community music venue at the heart of Birkenhead, on the left bank of the River Mersey.

We present the best contemporary music from across the globe on our stage (Doves, Gruff Rhys, The Coral, Black Country, New Road, OMD), while also giving emerging local artists the space, support and platform they need to thrive. At the same time, we reimagine a music venue as a learning opportunity: a space for young people to embark on life-shaping music pathways, through our cradle-to-career training programmes.

A lofty ambition this may be – but we believe music can be a powerful lever for positive change in Birkenhead. A way to reimagine what our town means in the world, and to improve the lives of local people.

We took the keys to our Argyle Street home just before the COVID-19 lockdown. But we didn't let that stop us. Over the six years since then, we have:

- Hosted almost **900** shows
- Welcomed more than **120,000** music lovers through our doors
- Partied with over **3,000** children and parents at our Sunday-morning Mosh Tots shows
- Trained more than **300** young people through Sound Check, opening up career pathways into the live music industry
- Worked with **200+** local artists through tailored development support
- Distributed over **2,000** free Neighbourhood Tickets to people in our local area

We are located in one of the most deprived areas in the UK. Yet, every day, Future Yard unlocks positive, transformational change through the power of music.

This is what we do.
This is why it matters.



THE NEXT STEP

After five years – we're full.

Demand has outgrown our current 280-capacity live room. We're turning away shows. Our diary is oversubscribed. Training programmes are limited by our space. Larger artists simply need a bigger venue.

And we know they want to come.

From **Black Uhuru** to **English Teacher**, from **Everything Everything** to **Nadine Shah** – artists choose Future Yard. But we can't always say yes.

When we present larger shows in our garden, we rely on the Great British weather, expensive temporary infrastructure, and take on huge financial risk. A rained-off show could cost tens of thousands of pounds.

Meanwhile, grassroots music venues nationally operate on an average profit margin of just 0.48%.

Future Yard's mixed income model allows us to perform above this average – but a larger indoor venue would fundamentally strengthen our resilience. As a non-profit Community Interest Company, any surplus we create is reinvested directly into our programmes.

Stronger finances mean:

- More shows
- More adventurous programming
- More training opportunities
- Greater access for local people

Our basement studios are full. They're excellent rehearsal rooms, but not ideal for tuition, workshops or school delivery.

We have created the opportunity.
Now we need the space to realise it.

WHAT ARE WE BUILDING?

A new, 600-capacity indoor live music venue – connected to our existing home by a purpose-built studios complex.

- Full rolling access at ground level
- Dedicated raised viewing areas
- Platform lift access to stage
- A dedicated Changing Places facility
- Accessible studios with lift access and natural light

And at its heart is our commitment to environmental sustainability.

The building is designed as a low-energy venue, incorporating a sustainable heat recovery system, and forms a key part of our commitment to achieve operational Net Zero by 2030 – positioning Future Yard as one of the first arts organisations in the UK to do so.

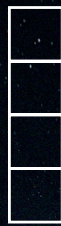
Working with longstanding partners **Adlib**, we will install best-in-class PA, lighting and AV infrastructure – maintaining the beautifully produced live shows we're known for.



Our 12 new, acoustically treated studios will be modular, able to partition into 15 teaching spaces. Perfect for:

- Individual tuition
- Band clubs
- Workshops
- Full class sessions
- Schools curriculum delivery

**By day, it becomes a learning lab.
By night, a world-class live venue.**



BUILD OUR FUTURE

Planning permission on these building expansion plans has been granted. So, what are we asking next?

95% of the £3million total project cost has already been secured through public investment.

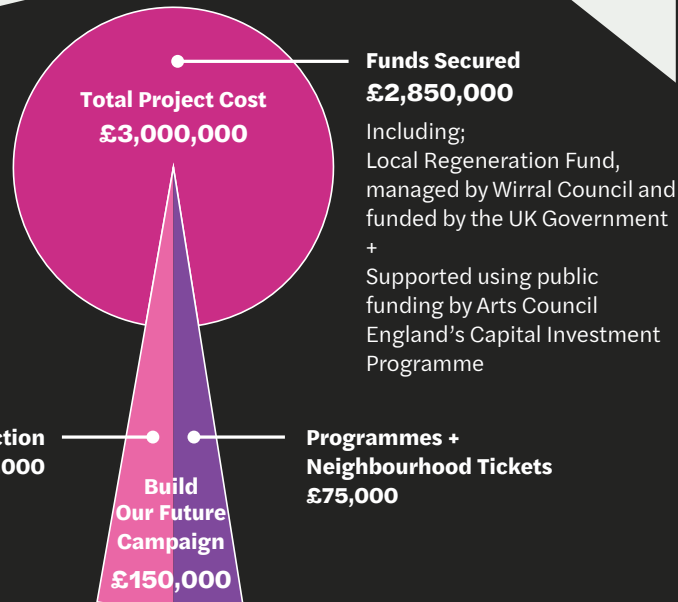
Through **BUILD OUR FUTURE**, we are raising the final **£150,000**.

50% will complete construction.
50% will directly fund access and opportunity – including:

- **1,000** free Neighbourhood Tickets
- **200** Mosh Tots tickets
- **20** Sound Check trainees
- **3** New Noise participants
- **5** Propeller workshops

WHY SUPPORT FUTURE YARD?

We are rooted here. Accountable here. Permanent here.

We own our building and site, giving us long-term security. We are not beholden to a landlord. We are here for generations to come.

Future Yard is an asset-locked, non-profit CIC, with an independent board of Non-Executive Directors. Any surpluses we make must legally be re-invested in our programmes.

Our founders are local. Our board is local.

We are a **team of 54 music lovers**; 85% of whom are under 35. 95% of our production team are Sound Check graduates.

Since 2020, 72.5% of attendees at our shows say their visit to Future Yard has positively changed their perspective of Birkenhead.

We are an **Arts Council England National Portfolio Organisation**, a **trusted partner of Wirral Council** and a **key driver of Birkenhead's regeneration**.

This project doesn't just build a venue. It turbo-charges our impact, and will directly enable:

- **50+** additional shows per year
- **150+** additional local artist performances
- A **50%** audience increase in year one – doubling by year five
- **2,000** additional Sound Check training hours
- **3,500** children accessing our schools music curriculum
- **50%** increase in Mosh Tots capacity
- **100%** increase in Neighbourhood Tickets – 2,000 distributed in year one

AAA (Access All Areas) is a music initiative from Future Yard that transforms your team into a live band — and your company values into an original song.

This is a unique opportunity to step into the life of a gigging musician and experience the creative journey first-hand; from rehearsal and songwriting, right through to performance and award ceremonies.

Access All Areas will **directly support the physical build of Future Yard's new 600-capacity performance space in Birkenhead.** The programme culminates in a

professionally staged live showcase in this new performance space, where companies perform head-to-head in a celebratory event, to an audience of colleagues, friends and supporters.

Participating organisations will **become part of the venue's legacy, with a permanent star plaque displayed within the new space,** recognising each organisation's contribution to the build.

Awards on the night will recognise outstanding live performance, alongside a public vote to decide the Best Original Song.

LET'S TELL THE WORLD YOUR STORY

At its heart, AAA is about more than performance.

It's about **unlocking creativity within organisations, strengthening teams, building cross-company networks** and generating **meaningful, shareable content that reflects your company's culture** and values in action.

Throughout the programme and at the live show, Future Yard captures **high-quality video content and professional photography,** creating a bank of **powerful assets for internal communications, employer branding and social media storytelling.**

Original songs will be recorded live on the night and **released as a curated AAA playlist, opening up public voting after the event** and extending the reach of the project beyond the venue, **driving engagement** across internal teams, clients, partners and wider audiences.
